1. Introduction

Color Keep is an effect plug-in for Adobe® After Effects® (AE). The Color Keep effect affects the alpha channel of a given image by keeping only the given color lists (the inverse of color key).

1.2. Install

The zip archive you can download from OLM OpenTools web site contains the files listed in Table 1. To install OLM Smoother copy the plug-in file (for windows: OLMSmoother.aex, for Mac: unzip OLMSmoother.plugin.zip) in A E plug-in directory

2. Using Color Keep

To apply the effect, use the menu: (Effects)→(OLM Plug-ins)→(Color Keep).

When you apply Color Keep the layer becomes black.

3. Color Keep Parameters

Color Keep parameters are as follows (Figure 2)

- **Enabled Color Num**—Choose the number of color you want to choose. By increasing this parameter, the number of “Color” parameter increase. You can increase it up to 100.
- **Color**—Choose the color you want to “keep”. The default is RGB= (0, 0, 0). That’s why at first application of the effect you will have the impression that nothing is selected. To select a color, you will have to first disable the effect once, pick the color and re-enable the effect.




Figure 4 Result after applying Color Keep

You can see in Figure 4 an example of use of Color Keep on the image of Figure 3.
